


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# Matching Student PSAT Scores to College Board Account

# Why match scores?

- The College Board encourages students to access their SAT Suite of Assessments scores through their College Board accounts
- Online score reports provide students their scores in a dynamic, flexible way, so students can best prepare themselves for success on the SAT and beyond.
- If a student name, DOB and address in their College Board account matches the name, DOB and address on a student answer sheet EXACTLY, their online score reports will be automatically uploaded to their College Board account
  - We understand that student information does not always match, and if a student is missing scores from their College Board account, they can retrieve the information by providing some basic information
- The following steps can be followed for all students who are missing scores for PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10 and PSAT 8/9

# Step 1 – Log into CB Account

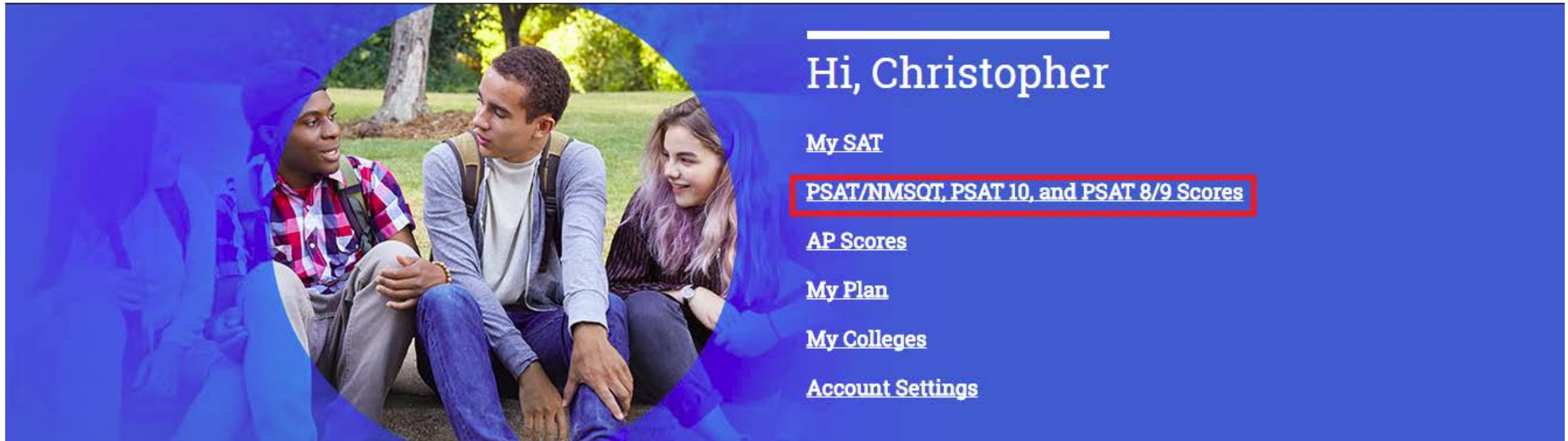

## Step 3 – If scores are not present, scroll down to find Matching Tool

**Students should verify that their scores have been released before utilizing the Matching Tool. If students attempt to access scores that have not yet been released, the Matching Tool will not be successful.**

### Don't See Your Scores?

If you took a test in the 2017-18 school year, check whether your scores have been released:

- PSAT/NMSQT: Scores are released December 11-13, 2017
- PSAT 10 and PSAT 8/9: Check with your school counselor

If your scores have already been released (including previous years):

1. You may need to update your account information. Go to the [Matching Tool](#) to verify. To make corrections, click 'Update'.
2. If you have a Registration Number for the SAT or Subject Tests, or an Access Code for PSAT-related assessments, go to the [Matching Tool](#) and click 'Get My Scores'.

# Required information

- In order to retrieve an online score report, students will need to enter the following information:
  - The test that was administered (PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10, PSAT 8/9 or SAT)
  - The year in which that test was administered
  - Their unique access code
- Access codes can be retrieved two ways:
  - By running a roster report in the K12 Assessment Reporting Portal for that administration of the test
  - Printed on the front of a student's paper score report
